Director of Athletics Position Description

Beyond management of the Upper School athletic programs, the Director of Athletics must see themselves as the leader of all athletic programs at Darlington, beginning with physical education class and after-school activities in the Pre-K to 8 Division and extending to our strength and conditioning programs and 23 varsity teams in the Upper School.

Reporting to the Head of School, the Director of Athletics is a key member of the school's leadership team. The ideal candidate will be a strong oral and



written communicator, who demonstrates a commitment to honor and integrity, passion for athletics, courageous decision-making, and a desire for a student-centered experience. The Director of Athletics fosters a positive and inclusive athletic community, building strong relationships with students, coaches, parents, and faculty. They skillfully navigate diverse viewpoints and disagreements, making difficult decisions with transparency and empathy, ensuring all stakeholders feel heard and supported. The Director of Athletics must be able to meet the physical demands of the job and thrive in a highly stressful work environment.

As a member of the Senior Administrative Team, Darlington's Director of Athletics is primarily responsible for:

- Working with coaches to develop and implement plans for each program.
- Providing opportunities for student success in education-based athletics.
- Assessing the school's athletic program.
- Identifying, developing, and empowering a dedicated coaching staff fostering a shared expectation of professionalism, continuous growth, and commitment to student success.
- Foreseeing the financial needs of the Athletic Department and administering the approved annual budget.
- Working with the school's Advancement Office in fundraising effort related to athletics.
- Working with the school's administration to establish and maintain the school calendar.
- Managing the school's athletic facilities.
- Working with the facilities department to prepare playing fields and transportation schedules.
- Overseeing the Athletic Booster Club.
- Coordinating with the school's Communication Office to publicize and promote student-athletes.
- Ensuring the school remains in compliance with athletic rules and regulations.
- Serving as the school's liaison to the Georgia High School Association.
- Attending regional and state athletic association meetings.
