Founded in 1907, Castilleja School has long been recognized as one of the nation's premier girls' schools. With 416 students in grades 6-12, Castilleja is rooted in its history, traditions, and a reputation for innovation embracing its motto, Women Learning, Women Leading. The school empowers young women to lead lives of purpose and impact.

Located in Palo Alto, California, in the heart of Silicon Valley, Castilleja has existed on the same picturesque campus since its founding. The School's facilities include state-of-the-art classrooms and science laboratories, a library, dedicated maker spaces, art studios, and collaborative learning environments. Athletics facilities comprise The Joan K. Lonergan Fitness and Athletic Center houses two gyms and fitness facilities, an outdoor pool for water polo and swimming, and a field for softball and soccer. A full campus renovation, scheduled for completion in 2027-28, will completely remake Castilleja with modernized teaching and learning spaces. These improvements will allow enrollment to grow to 500 students and will inspire new programs that align with the school's mission. The new campus will continue to center around The Circle, a geographic and cultural touchstone for the community. The Circle serves as a place for informal gatherings and cherished traditions, including graduation.

The Director of Athletics will:

- Continue the development of successful athletic programs, including the school's new and thriving flag football team.
- Plan for and maximize the use of Castilleja's athletic facilities, including a top-tier oncampus gym and the planned state-of-the-art pool facility.
- Work creatively and purposefully to secure additional field and court space in Palo Alto during the school's \$200M campus renovation project.
- Recruit talented coaches and staff, ensuring thorough onboarding, ongoing mentoring support, professional feedback, and motivating professional development opportunities.
